To the Board of Public Works of the

Gentlemen: I desire to call the attention of your body to immediate need of at once repairing certain elevated roadways and of providing sufficient force and necessary material to make such repairs as may be required that these bridges may be maintained open for travel.

The Williams Avenue elevated roadway near Weidler St. the elevated roadway on Grand Avenue between East Washington Street and East Oak Street, the elevated roadway on Goldsmith St across the Montgomery Gulch, are in a dangerous condition and are the only ways of travel now open between different parts of the city.
